

Baker Chosen By Dolphins In Third Round Of 2018 NFL Draft



Former Ohio State linebacker Jerome Baker was picked by the Miami Dolphins in the third round (73rd overall) of the 2018 NFL draft on Friday night.

Baker (6-1, 229) declared for the draft after a 2017 junior campaign at Ohio State in which he registered a team-high 72 tackles, including 17½ tackles for loss and seven sacks. He logged a career-high 16 tackles in the 2017 Big Ten Championship Game win over Wisconsin. The Cleveland Browns was second on the squad in tackles in 2016 with 83 total stops, 19 fewer than Raekwon McMillan. For his career, Baker tallied 158 tackles, two interceptions, three fumble recoveries and two pass break-ups.
