

Baseball: Ohio State To Play 2025 Series At Globe Life Field, Home of Texas Rangers



Ohio State baseball had part of its 2025 regular season schedule announced and they will be playing at MLB's Texas Rangers' home of Globe Life Field in the 2025 Shriners Children's College Baseball Series which will take place from Feb. 28 to March 2.

The event will take place for the second straight year and for three separate weekends, the Buckeyes participating in the last of the three. The teams who will play that weekend with Ohio State are Auburn, Baylor and Oregon State. The Beavers are currently ranked sixth in the country this season.
