

Cooper, Berry, Saunders Out On First Ohio State Depth Chart



Ohio State released its first depth chart of the 2019 season, as well as an injury report updating which players are out for the game against Florida Atlantic, and which ones are a game-time decision.

And here is Ohio State’s full depth chart for the Florida Atlantic game.

Note Jashon Cornell and Zach Harrison stepping in for the injured Cooper, and Tuf Borland and Baron Browning both being listed as starters at middle linebacker.

The injured list included some big names, including captain and senior defensive end Jonathon Cooper, who was known to be injured, but now has been confirmed out against the Owls.

A pair of other seniors in tight end Rashod Berry and H-back C.J. Saunders will also be out in week one, along with defensive tackle Taron Vincent and linebacker Justin Hilliard.
