

# Highlights: Ohio State Grinds Out Another One



It certainly wasn't the prettiest win of the season for the Buckeyes, but Ohio State improved to 3-0 Saturday night with a 49-27 win over Rutgers. It also wasn't a night ridden with highlights for the Buckeyes, but we've got you covered for the big plays from OSU, provided almost entirely by quarterback Justin Fields.

Fields got into the action early, striking from 38 yards out on Ohio State's first drive of the game to find Jameson Williams for his first touchdown reception of the season.
